2 £320 per month! Ideal for a young professional, this unfurnished ground-floor apartment in a large Victorian house has one double bedroom and a spacious sitting room with French windows leading to a delightful small garden.	
3 This second-floor apartment in a purpose-built block has two bedrooms and a compact kitchen and sitting room. Available immediately, fully furnished – £170 per week. Not suitable for an elderly person (no lift).	
4 Available from September, a two-bedroomed ground-floor apartment with an exceptionally spacious sitting room/dining room. Available part-furnished or fully furnished at £125 per week. Large communal garden. Close to shops and bus routes.	
5 Only £595 per month, this beautifully decorated and fully furnished first-floor apartment has two bedrooms and forms part of a seventeenth-century farmhouse. Its rooms are small, but full of character.
