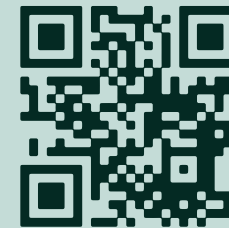

OUTCOMES

Based on a survey of 20 NeuroPraxis participants in 2021.

- 18 out of 20 reported substantial improvements with attention & concentration, and depression.
